CALL FOR CONTRIBUTIONS

How great is America?

The 10th International Festival of Geopolitics will take place at Grenoble Ecole de Management, Grenoble - France on 14th-17th March 2017. This 3 day event will bring together more than 100 specialists from all fields of geopolitical science. It will be attended by nearly 13000 people.

The 2018 edition will focus on the United States and its evolving political and economic role in the 21st Century.

The United States remains the world's largest economy in terms of GDP and the third most populous country in the world. It has dominated the international scene for almost a century.

However, in the last few years, the hegemonic status of the United States has been shaken. Firstly, by the economic and political growing power of Asia and other parts of the world and secondly by an internal desire to put "America first".

Based on these evolutions, what could be the United States' new role in coming decades?

To answer this question, Grenoble Ecole de Management is seeking contribution on the following (non exhaustive) themes:

- Diasporas and migrations
- Federalism and its Challenges
- The Presidential system and its checks and balances
- Populism, Democracy and Security Policies

- Social conflicts
- The image of the US through artistic expression (cinema, series, literature, etc.)
- The American Ideology

5. Mutual relationship between the United States and the rest of the world

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Within this framework, we call for contributions:

- open to those who work on this theme, whatever their discipline and their approach, and
 who could offer stimulating reflection to participants and more precisely researchers, heads
 of public and private institutions, civil servants and NGOs, reporters and journalists, private
 sector executives, artists...
- to contribute in different forms: conferences, debates, round tables, papers, ...
 Duration of a conference: 40mns. (+ 20mns. reserved for questions)
 Duration of a round table: 1h. (+ 20mns. reserved for questions)
- The program will have 80 interventions in total.

Conferences are aimed at a knowledgeable but non-specialist audience. Academic symposium papers are not suitable.

Three levels of presentation will be offered based on the audience concerned:

- Company and institutional managers
- Researchers, teachers, post-Bac students
- General public

Conditions for participation:

- Closing date for candidatures: July 15, 2017.
- The Festival will take place in Grenoble.
- For speakers, transportation to and from Grenoble in France and from bordering countries, and accommodation, are organized and paid for by Grenoble Ecole de Management.
 Note however that changes of tickets for personal reasons will not be supported by the organizers.
- Contributions are not remunerated.
- Speakers who wish to organize their own travel arrangements will be refunded after the Festival against a claim for expenses on the basis of a 2nd class SNCF ticket for travel within the geographical zones stated above.
- Presentations may be filmed (and broadcast on www.festivalgeopolitique.com or on our Youtube channel); the speaker must indicate his/her acceptance or refusal for this in the application form.
